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Patient Summary

Patient Overview

This 41-year-old male, self-employed in a STEM nonprofit, presents with a history of perennial/seasonal allergic rhinitis, oral allergy syndrome, and intermittent asthma ([CM-000039](#)). His allergic conditions are primarily triggered by tree, grass, weed pollens, alternaria, and cats ([CM-000039](#)). He also has a history of essential hypertension ([CM-000028](#), [CM-000030](#)). He is married with three children and recently underwent a vasectomy for permanent sterilization ([CM-000039](#)). He has been undergoing allergy immunotherapy for several years, with recent exacerbations linked to increased cat exposure ([CM-000039](#)).

Primary Medical Conditions

The patient's main conditions include allergic rhinitis and intermittent asthma, which manifest as nasal symptoms, chest tightness, and wheezing, particularly during pollen seasons and with cat exposure ([CM-000039](#)). Current Diagnosis

Confirmed diagnoses include perennial/seasonal allergic rhinitis/conjunctivitis due to multiple allergens, oral allergy syndrome, intermittent asthma, and essential hypertension ([CM-000039](#), [CM-000028](#), [CM-000030](#)). Recent lab work indicates a high HSV 1 IgG level of 5.69 MV ([CM-000002](#), [CM-000020](#)) and a high calcium level of 10.3 mg/dL ([CM-000002](#), [CM-000016](#)), which may warrant further investigation. Additionally, recent lab results from 01/09/2023 showed elevated total cholesterol (236 mg/dL), LDL (149 mg/dL), glucose (100 mg/dL), and total bilirubin (1.8 mg/dL) ([CM-000002](#), [CM-000014](#) - [CM-000001](#)).

Treatment History

The patient has been on allergen immunotherapy for approximately three years ([CM-000039](#)). For acute symptoms, he uses montelukast, azelastine, and Flonase ([CM-000022](#), [CM-000039](#)). Other medications for allergies include Ketotifen eye drops and Zyrtec ([CM-000027](#)). While immunotherapy has improved symptoms, exacerbations still occur, necessitating continued treatment and medication adjustments ([CM-000039](#)). He has received multiple COVID-19 vaccinations ([CM-000029](#)) and annual influenza vaccines ([CM-000027](#), [CM-000029](#) - [CM-000030](#)). A vasectomy was performed on 04/18/2023 ([CM-000039](#)), with post-procedure semen analysis ordered ([CM-000002](#)).

Functional Impact

The patient experiences chest tightness and wheezing with cat exposure, and nasal symptoms during pollen seasons, which can affect his daily comfort and activities ([CM-000039](#)). His new business and girlfriend's home involve increased cat exposure, directly impacting his respiratory health ([CM-000039](#)). Despite these challenges, he maintains a functional work capacity as self-employed in a STEM nonprofit ([CM-000029](#)). His chronic conditions are managed with medication and allergy shots, which likely mitigate significant daily functional limitations.

Case Complexity

This case is complex due to the interplay of multiple environmental allergens, the development of intermittent asthma alongside allergic rhinitis, and the patient's changing exposure to triggers through personal and professional life ([CM-000039](#)). The co-occurrence of chronic conditions including hypertension, asthma, and persistent allergic rhinitis requires ongoing specialist care and medication management. The need for continuous monitoring of various lab values (cholesterol, glucose, bilirubin, HSV 1 IgG, calcium) adds another layer of management. Additionally, the patient's insurance status changed to IHN ([CM-000022](#), [CM-000039](#)).

Current Status

The patient continues allergen immunotherapy and manages intermittent asthma, allergic rhinitis, and essential hypertension with medications and ongoing medical oversight ([CM-000039](#), [CM-000028](#), [CM-000030](#)). He is instructed to continue immunotherapy for two more years and follow up in one year ([CM-000039](#)). He recently completed a vasectomy procedure and is awaiting post-procedure follow-up. Recent lab results show elevated HSV 1 IgG and calcium, which are currently unaddressed in the treatment plan, along with elevated cholesterol, LDL, glucose, and bilirubin, indicating areas for continued monitoring.

He has been on allergy injections for nearly 2 years, no systemic reactions, maybestenosis of 0.4 mL full-strength bottles. This year he has had more symptoms during the grass pollen season and last year but still infinitely better compared to before shots. Only medication he takes is azelastine nasal spray 0.1%, 1 or 2 sprays each side p.r.n.. Never has to use Flonase or oral antihistamines or ketotifen eyedrops. He has not been around cats very much, but after purchasing the Queen B organizing business, sometimes he has to be in a house with a cat or where a cat has resided for 1-2 hours and that brings back to chest tightness wheezing causing him to leave. He has had asthma in the past from animals and when he was younger other triggers, not usually pollen, however. Presently does not have an inhaler. Still eats apples year-round no reactions to that, after eating a couple of peaches or nectarines he had minimal itching. Also had cherries which did not cause reaction recently. He no longer has private insurance, just IHN. PHYSICAL EXAMINATION: HEENT exam is normal. Lungs are CTA. DIAGNOSES Perennial/seasonal allergic rhinitis/conjunctivitis due to tree, grass, weed pollens, alternaria, and cats. Oral allergy syndrome due to stone fruits. Intermittent asthma. PLAN Remix allergy extract and continue allergen immunotherapy for 3 more years and I reviewed the reasoning behind that with the patient. Prior to cat exposure, use montelukast 10 mg and cetirizine 10 mg at least 2 hours before. He had montelukast in the past for pollen and was not helpful for that but now for the cat exposure especially since he has been on shots it should prevent asthma. I do not think he needs an inhaler at this point. When his azelastine nasal spray runs out, this is not covered by his insurance, so purchase OTC Astepro and use in similar p.r.n. fashion. Follow up in 1 year. He has been on allergy injections for 3 years, no systemic reactions, maintenance dose 0.4 mL full-strength bottles. He recalls having about 2 maybe 3 weeks of symptoms and this is late February or early March, so tree pollen season, ended up using Flonase and Astepro, not every day, and also got a refill of montelukast. He was trying to figure out if this was exposure to cats at his new girlfriend's home or pollen, but the symptoms did not persist so likely was pollen related. The grass pollen season he had no such peak of symptoms. Has not had to use any oral antihistamines or ketotifen eyedrops. He has been around cats more, both at the girlfriend's home and he purchased the Queen B organizing business, so he has to be in a house with a cat occasionally because of that. Prior to shots reactions to cats involved wheezing chest tightness, so asthma symptoms as well as nasal ocular symptoms. Presently does not have an inhaler Still eats and tolerates apples, he has plums cherries the summer peaches, a year ago ate those and had minimal itching. The last week or so he has had a stuffy nose sinus pressure, questions if he is sick or if this is allergies. ROS: No changes.
